- Approved the Mississauga First Nation Audited Financial Statements for the year ended March 31, 2011 presented by BDO Dunwoody
- Approved a tender to go out to the community for the Old School Bus
- Approved the sending of a letter from the Director of Operations (Jim Cada) to RDG regarding Land Issues
- Approved the Naadmaadwiuk Funding request for a band member to attend Transport Training for a duration of 6 weeks
- Approved the Naadmaadwiuk Funding request for a band member for Employment Start Up
- Approved BCR #010-11-12 for the Mississauga First Nation Trust to the purchasing of property owned by Mr. Scott Crawford. The property is located along Lake Duborne next to the Pow Wow grounds. Part of (44 acres), Concession Four (4), Lot Three (3), Parcel 2336 ACS.
- Approved the signing of the Negotiating Protocol Agreement regarding the Mississauga First Nation Flooding Land Claim
- Approved a band member of purchasing their house within a period of 3 months to have payment made to the band. If no payment is received by the deadline (of 3 months) a posting will go out to the community stating that a purchase can be made in a "as is" condition of the unit
- Approved the recommendation from the Housing Committee to have Evelyn Niganobe sit on the Housing Committee
