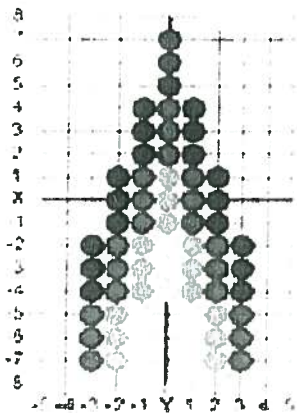

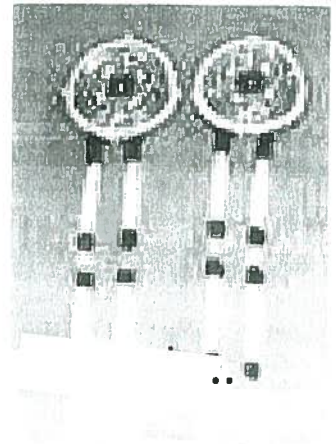

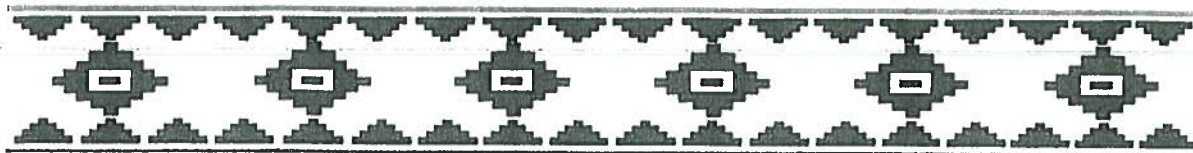

Prior Approvals are done for those clients traveling to Sudbury, London, Toronto, Espanola and other destinations outside our Agreement.
