Baitfish Harvesting

Commercial Baitfish Harvesting areas are available. Please contact the office for more information if you wish to harvest baitfish for commercial purposes.

Commercial Fishers

Please contact our office if you wish to engage in Commercial Fishing in Lake Huron. Our fishing quota has been set and available for harvest. Keep in mind that this license does not affect your Rights as a First Nation person.

Fuelwood Lots

Personal Use fuelwood lots are available on the Old Steel Road. Other sites are being explored that may be closer to the community. Remember, these lots are for personal use only! No commercialization will be permitted. Please inquire at the office for a permit and location.

Fur Harvesting Course/Traplins

If there is anyone interested in taking the Fur Management Training Course (Trapping) please submit your names ASAP. In addition, the MNR on very rare occasions will have registered vacant traplines available throughout our Traditional Lands. These Traplines range from 10 km to over 100 km away from the community. If you have an interest in a vacant trapline please contact our office to provide you full details.
