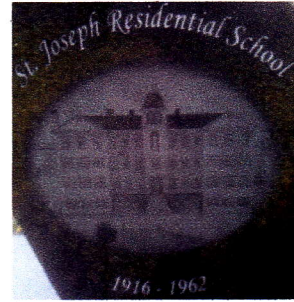
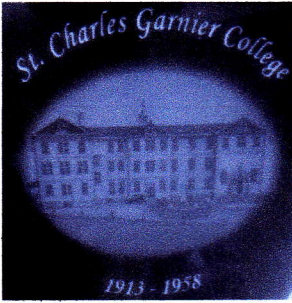
**Packages are currently being prepared with a more formal agenda/times and will be made available at time of registration.**
