## 1. ADMINISTRATION/HEALTH BUILDING - 8 LABOURER POSITIONS

- the eight (8) men that have been selected

*Travis Niganobe, Ted Boyer Jr., Mike Chiblow, Mitchell Cada, Jamie Morningstar  
Glen Armstrong, Charlie Chiblow, Cletus Boyer*

- there might be a need to call on a few of these men sooner
- order of call - Travis, Ted Jr., Mike
- there is a meeting scheduled for June 4/96 at 11:00 o'clock with the men to go over policies
- the policies will be defined clearly, the band will not tolerate absenteeism, lateness, drinking, etc.

## 2. PROJECT LIAISON OFFICER

- seven resumes were received
- the team requires someone that can do the job
- Jim has consulted with Frank Paibomsai, Brian Porter and Calvin Jamieson regarding James Owl's qualifications and education
- must do hands on work
- four Council members agreed with hiring James Owl, there was one abstention
- the BCR #032-96-97 will be forwarded on to NORTOP
- another suggestion was to find out if Frank Paibomsai could be requested from the NSTC to work in Mississauga
- Jim called, Frank stated that he was committed to another job in Garden River but will keep in close contact with Mississauga

## 3. LAKE HOPE ROAD MAINTENANCE

- Graeme Lowry has contacted Chief Boyer stating that M.T.O. refuses to do any work on this road until the road is brought up to standards
- Graeme received a quote from Joe Iturregui and it is approximately \$1000.
- Graeme asked if the band is interested in going splits for upgrading the road
- no decision was made
- Chief Boyer to bring this up with the Implementation Committee

## 4. R & R DAY

- July 12/96 will be an employee R & R Day
- Ruth and Kathy state that with their programs, someone will have to work
- there will be meetings with their staff to find out who will participate
- cost analysis will be performed to cover for this day
- this item will be on the agenda for the next C & C meeting

## 5. JET FUEL SPILL

- Glen Austin provided an update, no claim was submitted for the tree loss
- appropriate samples will be forwarded to the University of Guelph for an analysis
- low cost of \$100 to pursue
- Jim Cada Sr. also stated that black loam was taken out but was replaced with gravel
- Chief Boyer stated that Dan Newman Minister of Aboriginal Affairs would be requested to do a follow-up

## 6. OTHER BUSINESS

### a) Ditching

- the ditches have to be cleaned
- a 36" wide bucket will be purchased at a cost of \$1700.

### b) Forestry

- Jukka from North Shore Tribal Council called and stated that more dollars can be accessed from NODA in order to continue on the forestry strategy
- would like to have input on hiring for the position of Forestry Officer
- Annie stated that Mike G. Boyer has graduated with his certificate
- she also stated that the Science Camp will plant and supply the trees on July 14/96 and wanted to know what area would need some trees
- Jim stated on the big hill towards the pit

### c) Self Government

- received confirmation that the North Shore Tribal Council received another \$700,000 for this initiative
- this means that Mississauga First Nation will get their \$50,000 supplement

### d) Payroll/Finance Clerk

- the job description must be prepared and a posting will go out to the community

### e) Housing

- the schedule for the building of this year's homes will be in this order:
