TRUST MANAGER'S REPORT APRIL 27, 2023

FINANCE

As of March 31, 2023, the capital portfolio account had an ending portfolio balance of \$8,4365,219.72 and the revenue portfolio had an ending portfolio balance of \$982,147.62. Dividends and interest earned in March were \$47,227.66 in the capital portfolio and \$2,214.57 in the revenue portfolio.

LANDS

Regarding the King property, the severance application has been made and the Town of Blind River has issued a notice that any taxpayers having concerns/issue regarding the severance of the property has 30 days to send in their concerns (Last day May 1, 2023).

ADMINISTRATION

I have spoken to the Trust auditor and the 2022 tax return has been filed and the draft audit is complete. She will be preparing the draft documents and sending them to the Trust and will meet with the Trustees to review the audit.

Fourteen (14) inquiries have been received since the last Trust meeting. Eleven inquiries were under the membership stream (10 health and 1 education), one under the community plan and two under the community project stream. One inquiry under health was directed to Jordan's Principle. Two applications were emailed to the applicants, five were downloaded and one was completed in the Trust office. One application required more information which wasn't received prior to the Trust meeting.
