



## **COVID 19 Update**

Community spread of COVID 19 is present in the surrounding communities.

This update is in response to the recent notice to the **potential** exposure at the Blind River Public School grade 3/4 class and who should be self-isolating along with their household. Please respect their privacy and hope for their safety.

Algoma Public Health is advising anyone who has visited Tim Hortons in Blind River either through walk in or drive through on the following dates and times of a **potential low risk exposure** to COVID 19.

January 30, 2021 – 4:00am-12 noon

January 31, 2021 – 4:00am – 12 noon

February 1, 2021 – 8:00am – 11:45am

Actions to take, people who visited are asked to **self-monitor** for signs and symptoms of COVID 19 for 14 days from **potential exposure**.

**Self-isolate immediately** should symptoms develop and **seek testing** should symptoms occur.

It is now more important than ever to follow public health measures:

- Only go out if it is necessary
- Bring your hand sanitizer in your pocket
- Wash your hands often
- Wear your mask
- Avoid touching your face, eyes, nose and mouth
- Stay home if you are sick and get tested

- If you have been exposed to someone with respiratory symptoms or COVID 19 please book an appointment for testing and stay home.

Good afternoon,

This is an urgent message from the Algoma District School Board. We have been advised that Algoma Public Health is currently investigating a potential COVID-19 exposure in the Blind River Public School community, affecting the grade 3/4 class. As a result, the class must be dismissed immediately and all members of the grade 3/4 class are to stay home and self-isolate until midnight February 10, 2021. Algoma Public Health will be contacting families individually to provide further direction.

Please contact the school to arrange pick up of your child immediately if they are in the grade 3/4 class. When picking up your child, it is recommended that they remain masked and isolated from any other siblings.
